### **1.4 Feedback Committee Report:**

A committee of 12 members is formed to collect and analyze feedback. The committee prepares the time-bound schedule for feedback collection with congruence to academic calendar. The feedback is taken on different criteria /factors which includes the feedback on syllabus and its transaction at the institution, the feedback about college and its infrastructure, feedback from alumni, parents, etc. These stakeholders are also involved for suggestions for the measures of improvement.

Feedback committee and IQAC draft the questionnaire for feedback, the questions are designed to extract out the strengths and area of upgradation/ improvements of the institute. The suggestions are collected from the stakeholders. Feedback is collected from these stakeholders in an online mode. All the data collected is stored by feedback committee. Feedback committee processes and analyzes the data with the help and guidance of IQAC cell. The observations made by the committee are discussed with all the staff members and proposed measures of improvement are undertaken. The overall feedback mechanism is the key parameter to develop a fruitful environment and improvement of the institute.

The views/opinion of teachers are discussed in the meeting. Teachers' active participation in the meeting and in different committees is recorded and their suggestions, ideas and issues (if any) are forwarded to the Principal and office for consideration and necessary action. The college is run by Shikshan Prasarak Mandal, a parent organization of the institute. The Principal and the managing committee of Shikshan Prasarak Mandal are the employers who offer feedback in management committee meetings. The Principal records the feedback and takes necessary action to implement the same in accordance with the suggestion made by management.

The Principal, teaching staff and office staff endeavors to live up to the expectation of management.

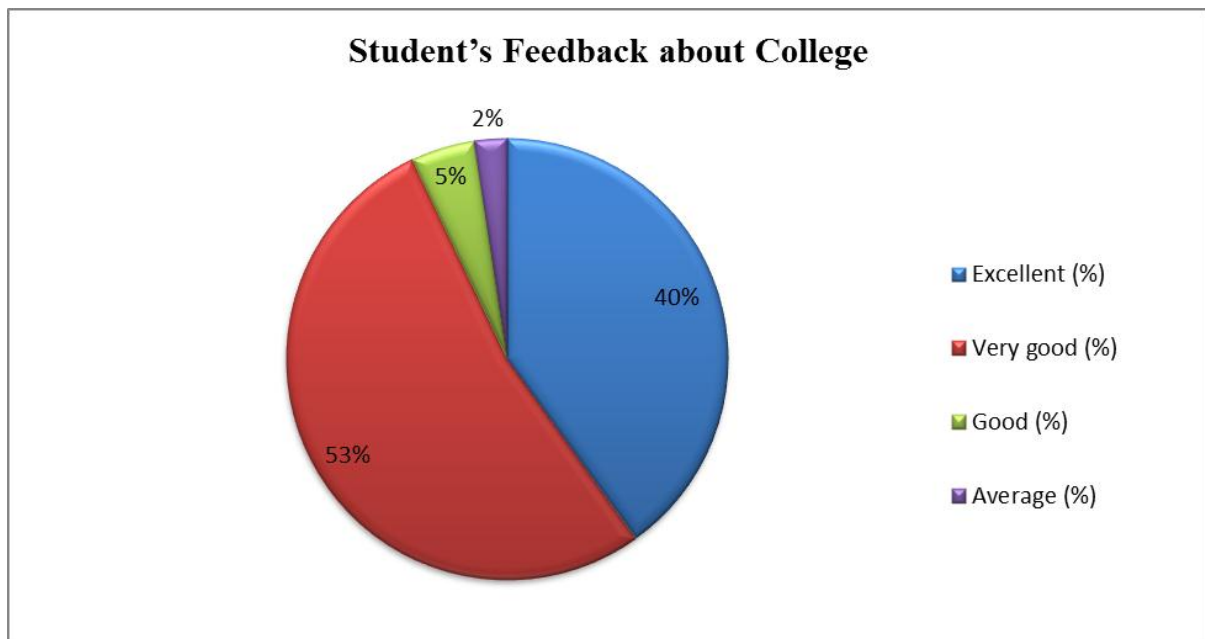

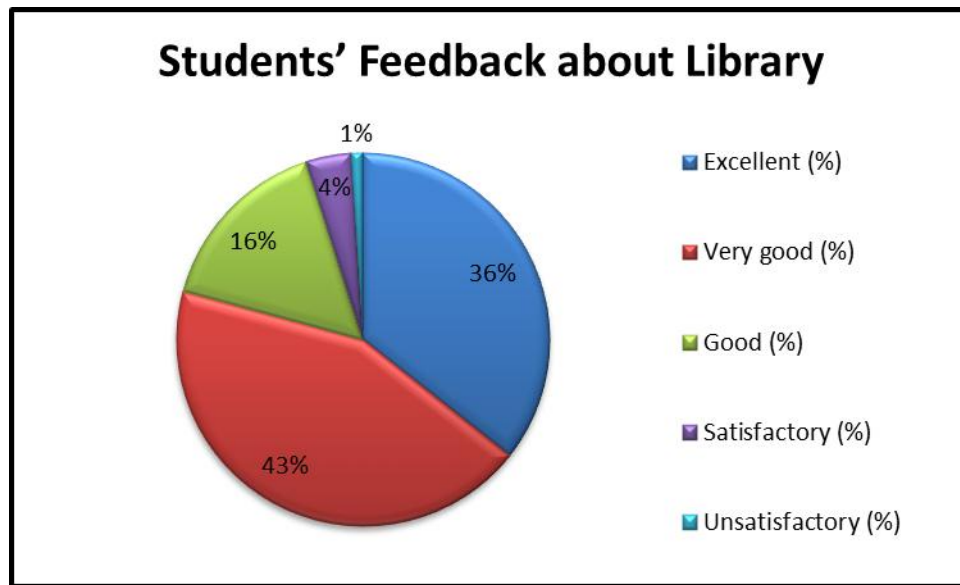

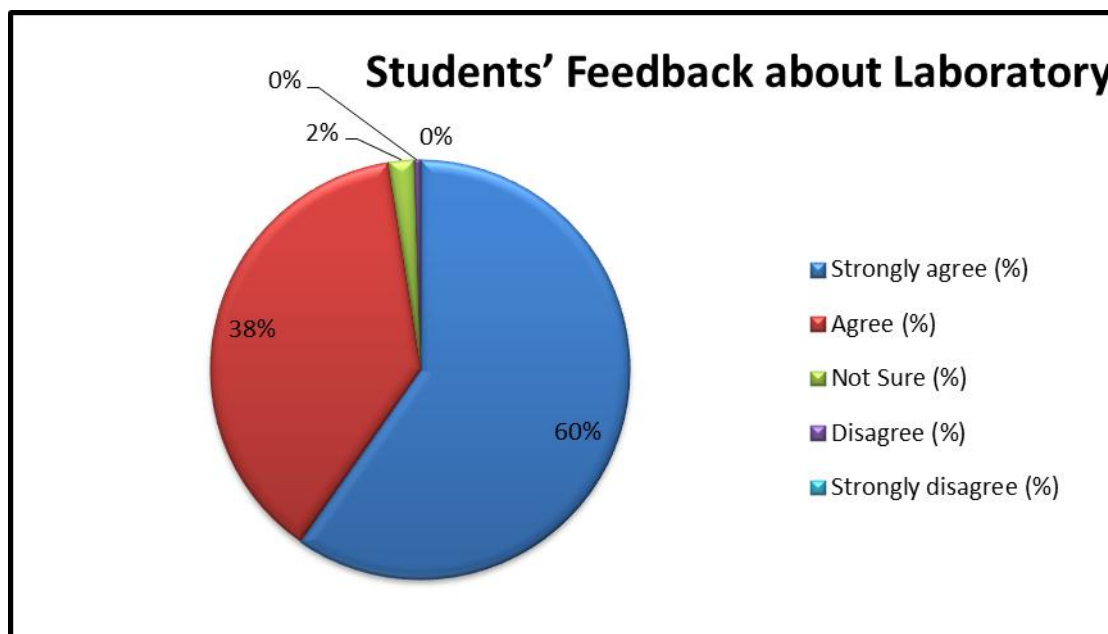

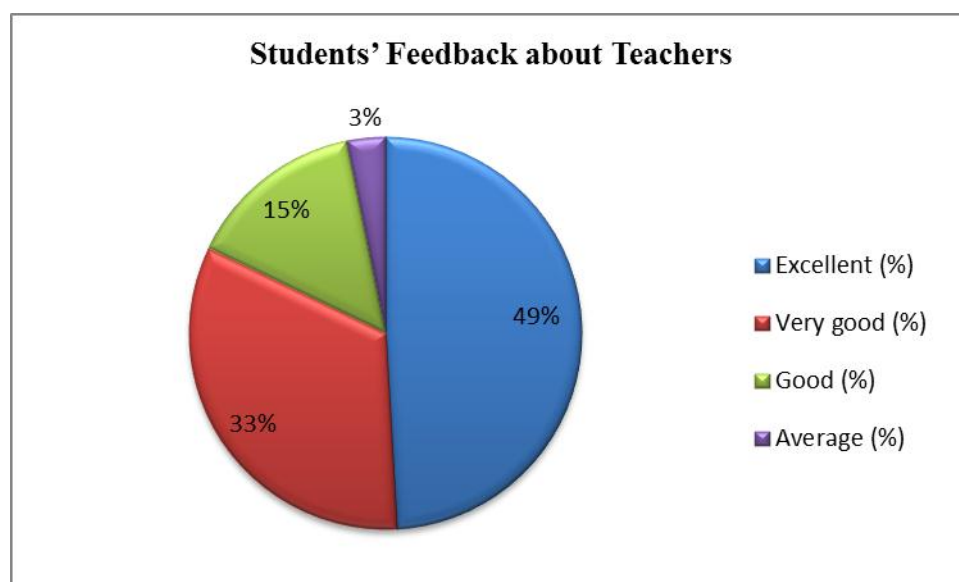
